#### **EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S WELCOME LETTER**

"The purpose of the Nanaimo Conservatory of Music is to foster excellence in the performing arts in the Central Vancouver Island Region."

The Nanaimo Conservatory of Music began as the Central Vancouver Island Community Music School in 1977, with six teachers and thirty students. Before the existence of the school, students often had to travel to Victoria or Vancouver for lessons in specific disciplines, especially those who wished to be instructed at higher levels. Since 1977 the CVICMS/NCM has provided high-quality instruction in a wide variety of individual instruments in both classical and jazz traditions, as well as ensembles and orchestral groups. These ensembles and groups include Youth/Prelude Orchestra, Intermezzo Strings, Cello Choir, harp ensembles, and the Nanaimo Youth Choir.

We recognize that it is critical that beginners are taught by highly skilled and qualified teachers, the NCM has placed an emphasis on youth and the young beginner, while at the same time offering instruction to all age groups and levels. Our students annually participate in the upper Island Music Festival, are encouraged to take the RCM examinations and to complete in other music festivals and competitions and perform in annual NCM recitals.

All of our faculty work very hard to ensure that individual and group lessons are a positive learning experience and are eagerly looking forward to seeing everyone again in the fall.

#### Communicable Illness policy

Use the hand sanitizer station when entering the NCM.

Do not enter the NCM if you are feeling ill, and speak to your instructor about online lessons option.

Masks are not mandatory but are recommended.

Wipe down all stands and chairs with cleaner provided in each studio and the ensemble room

#### **SCHOOL TERM**

Students will enroll for either the School Term (September through June) and/or Summer Term (July & August). Tuition payments are calculated according to the number of lessons in each term.

#### STATUTORY HOLIDAYS

Some instructors may elect to come in and teach on statutory holidays. Some instructors have indicated they may not teach on statutory holidays. All tuitions will reflect the preference of each individual instructor. Please check with your instructor to go over your schedule if you have questions.

#### **IMPORTANT DATES 2023 - 2024**

The NCM office will be closed during all \* statutory holidays and is open limited hours in July and August.

#### **INDIVIDUAL INSTRUCTION**

Students typically have one lesson per week from September to June, unless alternate arrangements are made directly with the office and instructor. Students may begin individual lessons at any time during the school year.

#### **SUZUKI INSTRUCTION**

Enables students to start lessons at a much earlier age than traditional lessons taken without parent supervision. The Suzuki method also involves the parent 100% of the time, and involves group lessons with other Suzuki students studying the same instrument.

Students will be referred to an appropriate instructor based on: musical background, goals, availability, and fee options. Students may request lessons with a specific instructor, but the NCM cannot guarantee availability.

#### **GROUP CLASSES AND ENSEMBLES**

Students in group classes typically begin their studies in September. Classes fill up quickly. If space permits and the instructor agrees, a student may join a class already in progress.

#### **TUITION**

**Tuition and other fees must be paid before a student's first lessons, class or ensemble**. There are several ways to pay tuitions; cheque, cash, credit card/debit or E-transfer. A monthly payment plan is also available with a void cheque or credit card information.

#### **PAYMENT**

Payment is required at the time of registration for the current term. Method of payments accepted are cheques, debit card, credit card, E-transfer or cash. A monthly payment plan is available upon request. There is a form to fill out accompanied by a void cheque. The total tuition is paid over equal monthly installments by pre-authorized debit on the 30th of each month, beginning with the first month of enrollment and continuing until the end of the term.

#### **FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE**

Bursary applications are available by request through the office. Bursaries are applied as a discount against tuition fees. Bursaries only cover a portion of tuition costs and are not refundable.

Bursary applications are excepted between June - August, prior to the start of the new lesson year.

#### **CANCELLATION POLICY**

Students are expected to be present for all scheduled lessons. There are **NO** refunds on cancelled lessons by students. If an instructor cancels a lesson, your instructor is obligated to make up that lesson.

The NCM reserves the right to cancel, postpone, or combine classes and to limit registration or change instructors. Should insufficient registration cause the cancellation of a class, fees will be refunded, or the student may transfer to another class if room is available.

#### **REGISTRATION FEE**

The Registration Fee is non-refundable and due every year. The fee covers the lesson year from July to June.

#### **REFUNDS AND WITHDRAWALS**

#### **Group Classes and Ensembles**

Full refunds will be processed by contacting the office a minimum of 72 hours before the program start date (less supply costs). Full refunds are issued when the NCM cancels a program. *Refunds will not be given once the course begins*, except in cases of illness or injury, accompanied by a doctor's letter. If a doctor's letter is produced, a pro-rated refund will be given for the class.

#### **Individual Lessons**

A two-lesson notice is required to withdraw from individual or Suzuki lessons. In the case of injury or illness only, the two lesson notice will be waived upon receipt of a doctor's letter. Once notice is received and confirmed by the teacher, then a refund can be processed.
